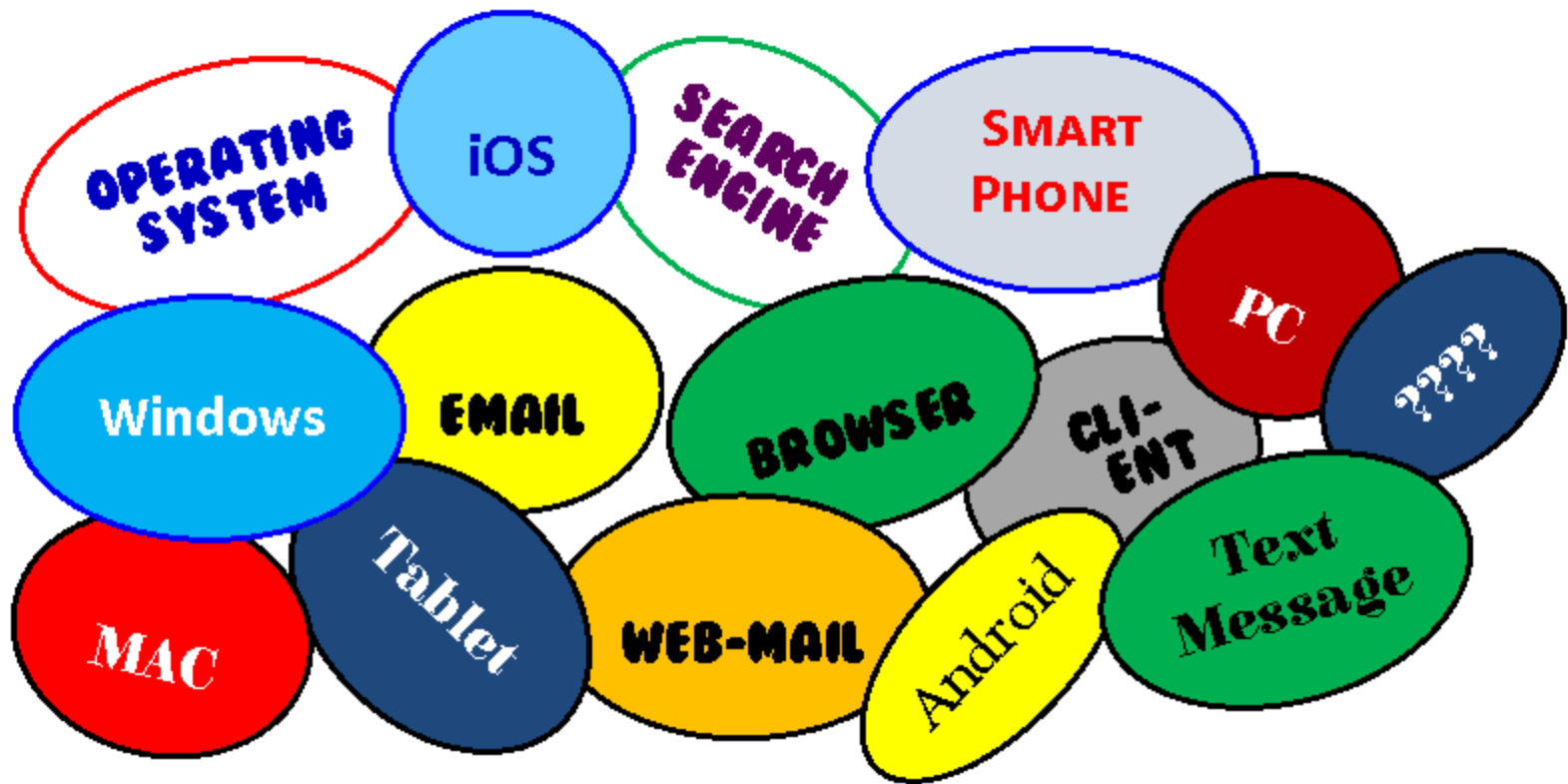

OPERATING SYSTEM

- An operating system (OS):
 - a component of the system software that manages computer hardware and software resources
 - provides common services for computer programs.
- Application programs require an operating system to function

OPERATING SYSTEM

- Windows (All versions) is an operating system produced by Microsoft.
- iOS (All versions) is an operating system produced by Apple
- Linux (All versions) is an operating system developed by Palm, acquired by HP and now "open sourced" (available to any developer). Chrome is a Linux based OS.

Web Browser

- A Software Program:
 - Used for displaying and viewing pages on the World Wide Web
 - That allows the user to find and read encoded documents in a form suitable for display, especially for use on the World Wide Web.
 - Internet Explorer, Safari, Chrome, Edge, Mozilla, Etc

SEARCH ENGINE

A program that searches for and identifies items in a database that correspond to keywords or characters specified by the user, especially for finding particular sites on the World Wide Web.

EMAIL

1. Messages distributed by electronic means from one computer user to one or more recipients via a network.
2. Message or messages sent or received by such a system.
3. To send (someone) an e-mail: “I’ll e-mail my schedule”.
4. To send (a message) by e-mail.

WEB MAIL

1. a system of electronic mail that allows account holders to access their mail via the internet site rather than downloading it onto their computer
2. A service providing the ability to read and send e-mail at a website.

Email Client

1. Primarily a desktop application that enables users to receive and send emails directly on their desktop
2. Also known as “email reader”
3. A computer program used to read and send electronic messages

Text Messaging

TEXTING: composing and sending electronic messages between two or more mobile phones, or fixed or portable devices over a phone network
