

# A Quick Look At Apple Pages

Several years ago, Apple created the iWork suite for the Macintosh. The suite included the Pages program. Pages had a role similar to Microsoft Word in the Microsoft Office suite on Windows. iWork was a boxed product sold at a price less than Microsoft Office.

Later Pages was added to the iPad and iPhone and the Macintosh version was made more like the iOS versions. Pages was also added to Apple's [iCloud.com](https://www.icloud.com) web offering. Apple has made Pages (and the rest of the iWork suite) free.

Now Pages is much improved in all of its forms. But...the newest Pages requires macOS High Sierra to run. The web form of Pages can be used in most modern web browsers.

During the June 18 "All Things Apple" meeting of Port Ludlow Digital Life we will take a quick look at the Macintosh and web versions of Pages while also mentioning the iOS versions.
